

# What should you do if the Community Standard is compromised? COVID-19 Edition

*It's often difficult to confront people, whether they be your friends or strangers, when you see them violating the Community Standard. But in the context of COVID-19, it is more important than ever to abide to our community rules to keep everyone safe. This guide is designed to help you confront, report, and prevent community violations.*

## 1. Confront

If it is safe for you to do so, calmly approach the individual and ask them politely to discontinue their behavior

*"Hi! Could you please keep your masks on and keep 6 feet apart? Thank you!"*



## 2. Reporting
